Regular Meeting of Lake Shore City Council Monday, May 24, 2021 7:00 PM Lake Shore City Hall

Police Report – Officer Steve Sundstrom

<u>Incident Report</u> – In April 2021 there were 80 incidents in the City. There were 56 traffic-related incidents and 24 were miscellaneous department activity.
